USE INSECT REPELLENT

Use insect Repellents Containing 30% Deet



WEAR PROTECTIVE CLOTHING

Socks, Shoes, Long pants, Long Sleeve shirts



PROOF HOME

keep screens on windows and doors closed.



MOSQUITO PREVENTION



Remove Standing Water

Mosquitoes lay their eggs in standing water. Empty, remove, flip or cover and receptacles that can hold water.



Stop The Water Source

Repair any leaking faucets, pipes, or drain hoses in and around your home. As an added bonus, you'll save on your waterbill!



Ensure The Flow

Clean out any clogged roof gutters. If you have a flat roof, make sure it is draining properly.

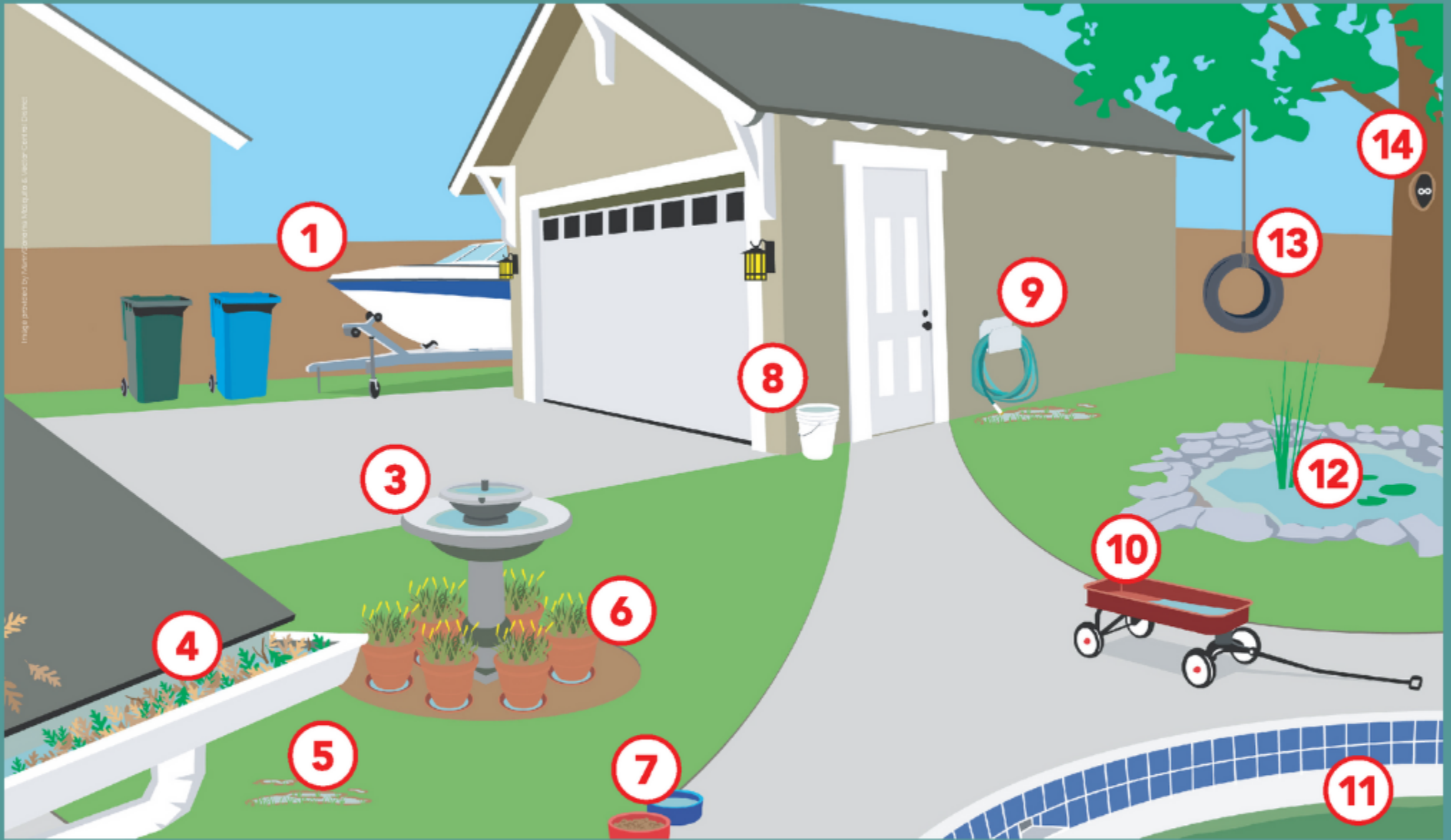


Tend To The Trees
